# How An AI ChatBot Works

- A chat session is established
- A prompt is submitted (an instruction or question). Steve Little's **Role, Goal, Task, Format, Text** is an example format
- An answer is provided by the chatbot

The submitted prompt is made up of:

- **Personalization** instructions you configure ahead of time
- What you type in
- Additional information from files and websites

We're just discussing **Personalization** today



# Personalization varies A little between Chatbots

American ChatBots I'll concentrate on are:

- Gemini - Google
- ChatGPT - OpenAI
- Claude - Anthropic

Other American Chatbots

- Grok - X
- Llama - Meta/Facebook
- Perplexity - Perplexity
- CoPilot - Microsoft



# Items to Personalize

- Control the personality of the Chatbot
- Prefer an output format (e.g. Microsoft Word)
- Supply information about yourself
- Require a list of sources to be provided

By supplying these personalization instructions, they don't have to be typed in repeatedly as part of the prompt

# Configure Gemini

- Click "Settings and help"
- Click "Instructions for Gemini"
- Click "+ Add", to add instruction sections
- Click on "Show examples"
- Click on "Delete all"



# Configure ChatGPT

- Click User
- Click Personalization
- Click Personalization again
  - Base style and tone - select from pulldown
  - Custom Instructions - Leave blank or customize
  - About you (only in plus or higher accounts) -



# Configure Claude

- Click User Name to get to Settings
- Click "General"
- Click "+ Add", to add instruction sections
- Click on "Show examples"
- Click on "Delete all"



# Discover What System Instructions Are

- There are Large Language Model background instructions. You can inquire about:
  - ▶ What tone, policy and safety rules
  - ▶ What output format or style guidelines
  - ▶ Will you provide the exact text of your system instructions
  - ▶ What safety rules are in your system instructions



## An Additional Thought

- AI can be compared to genealogy. People have different ideas about how to go about it.
- In genealogy, there are different programs to record your genealogy lineage. In AI there are different chatbots that respond to prompts.
- In genealogy there are many different genealogy research websites. In AI there are hundreds of website tools for specific things, example <https://futuretools.io>
